Complete Application Includes:

2. (Document B) – A **CONFIDENTIAL** instructor recommendation form and letter completed by the instructor and given to the student in a sealed envelope. The instructor's signature should be placed across the sealed portion of the envelope.
3. (Document C) – A **CONFIDENTIAL** recommendation letter completed by a supervisor, school counselor, pastor or mentor. Their signature should be placed across the sealed portion of the envelope.
4. The student's official high school transcript of grades – to be obtained and sent by the student with the application.

General Instructions:

1. The student must complete the application.
2. Section I – Personal Information and Interests must be completed on the original Scholarship Application Form.
3. Sections II and III may be computer generated and completed on separate pages to be attached to the Application.
4. Any section of the Scholarship Application not completed by the computer must be legibly completed in ink.
5. Check your application carefully. Be sure that all required information is given and the application is signed.
